Regular Agenda – Hiring a fourth employee

The responsibilities in our services to the community have expanded over the years. From a simple office job of basically paying utility bills and filing, to a active Senior program, an busy public relations program, a major maintenance department, patients' rights advocacy and more.

The amount of work has at least doubled and Corning Healthcare District's positive reputation of service to the community is has greatly increased.

There are some expected changes in the next couple of years, including the possible retirement of the District manager at the end of her current term.

Recommendation. Because time has a way of passing much quicker than any of us like to think, Director Yvonne Boles recommends that the District begin the process of training a replacement now, for the following reasons.

- 1. There is much to learn for anyone who takes the District Manager's place
- It is possible that the manager train someone and that person decide they don't care for this type of work. That would cut the training time considerably and could leave the District in a difficult situation
- 3. The first year is training in office programs and procedures.

- 4. The second year would be training specifically in District Function, the laws and personnel management
- 5. The third year would be a slow reversal of roles so that in April of 2021 the District manager would become a part-time assistant and her assistant become the manager.

A resident of Corning for the past 15 years, Karen has been local her whole life. What to do with all those eggs after Easter?

Irish-Style Pickled Eggs



- 12 hard-cooked eggs
- 1 oz fresh root ginger, peeled
- 1 tbsp peppercorns (preferably white, but black will do)
- 2 tsp allspice berries
- 1½ 2 pints white vinegar

If you want a bit of a kick, add 2 or 3 fresh red or green chilis or red chili flakes to taste.

Add the ginger, peppercorns and allspice to the vinegar and boil for 5 minutes. You can tie up the spices in a bit of muslin or simply strain it when it's finished boiling.

Remove the spices from the vinegar and let the vinegar cool.

Peel the eggs, pack into wide-mouthed jars and cover with the cold spiced vinegar. Add a chili or two for color and bite. Be sure the eggs are completely submerged in the vinegar. Seal and store for a month before opening.
